

Minutes TC-10 meeting - August 17th 2011 Long Beach, CA

- TC-10 is the second highest TC in terms of number of submitted papers
- Workshop Fundamentals of Signal Integrity, attendees of approximately 60 people
- SI sessions (Signal Integrity 1-3): average of 45-50 people per session, very successful sessions so far.

- Special session for 2012 EMC proposed by Jianmin Zhang, CISCO and Ye Chunfei, INTEL: **“Channel characterization and modeling for high speed signaling”**.

- Workshops: *Fundamentals of Signal Integrity* (half day) and *advanced topic on Signal Integrity* (second half day, proposed topics are packaging, connectors and power integrity). Chairs: Ege Engin, San Diego State University Bill Chen, Tsinghua University, China, Yaojiang Zhang, MST.
