



Annual Meeting at the 2006 IEEE International Symposium on EMC at Portland, Oregon Wednesday, August 16, 2006

Confirmed July 11, 2007

- 1. Chairman William (Bill) Radasky brought the meeting to order at 12:13 pm. Our Secretary, Randy Jost, is stepping down. Bill and Mike McInerney, the Vice Chairman, will act as co-secretaries for this meeting. All the members present introduced themselves, and the following items were discussed.
- 2. Twelve papers were reviewed by TC-5 for the 2006 EMC Symposium: 10 were accepted, 2 were rejected. Of the 10 accepted papers: 7 were oral in the HPEM session, 1 was open forum (poster), and 2 oral papers were transferred to other sessions for presentation. This is the second year that full papers (preliminary) were required. The papers were submitted electronically (in Adobe PDF format) to the EMC paper review website and the Technical Activities Chair (TAC) assigned the papers to a technical committee for review. The TC chair assigned three reviewers for each paper. The reviewers were able to download the papers from the website. The reviewers submitted their reviews electronically, with comments, to the website. This is where the process deteriorated. Bill bemoaned the complicated method needed to consolidate the reviews and to submit the summary. He hoped that this would improve for next year's conference, as it required more work than the old manual system for the volunteers reviewing papers.
- 3. Paper reviewers are great. Please volunteer to be a paper reviewer.
- 4. Bill announced that on Friday afternoon at 1:00 pm there will be a TC5-spnsored tutorial on ESD (FR-PM-WS-18: Having ESD Problems? From Basics to Solutions). It is chaired by David Pommerenke, U. of Missouri Rolla.
- 5. Bill reviewed the 2005 minutes. They were unanimously approved.
- 6. An attendance form was distributed. Attendees are requested to provide their name, organization and email address.
- 7. Bill Radasky provided an update on IEEE P1642 Recommended Practice for Protecting Public Accessible Computer Systems from Intentional EMI and IEEE P1643 Recommended Practice for Protecting Voting Equipment and Systems from Intentional EMI activities, both of which he is chairing. This year's symposium committee meeting was yesterday, Tuesday, from 7:00 to 9:00 am. The first draft was reviewed. The second draft is planned for distribution 30 November. The final draft will be distributed 31 March. The final draft will





be discussed at the 2007 EMC Symposium, Honolulu, Hawaii July 8 - 13, 2007. The document will then be prepared for the voting process.

- 8. Mike McInerney reported on the status of the web page. He recently updated it and as of this meeting, it is current. A suggestion was made by Elya Joffe to add links to HPEM, IEMI and lightning conferences under links. This will be considered, however, it is difficult to keep such links up to date.
- 9. There were seven HPEM or IEMI conferences (or sessions/tutorials) over the past 12 months:

 - AMEREM, Albuquerque, U.S.A., July 2006
- 10. Dr. Rachidi spoke on the planned lightning tutorial for Hawaii 2007.
 - Based on Singapore tutorial
 - A presentation of the suggested topics and preliminary speakers was given
 - One to one and one half day tutorial
 - Can be split into two parts, if necessary
 - December 15 is workshop deadline
 - Workshops will be Sunday and Monday at Hawaii
- 11. Fred Heather suggested having a separate tutorial on aircraft lightning
 - Two-hours on direct effects
 - Two-hours on indirect effects
 - Attachment zones, test methods, magnetic flux, ignition vs. spark free design
 - As Dr. Rachidi's workshop had been recommended by TC-5 to the IEEE during the 2004 IEEE Chicago symposium, it was not clear that this new recommendation could be accommodated by the 2007 Hawaii Conference Committee. If not, it would be considered for 2008.
- 12. Fred Heather suggested special session on aircraft lightning for Hawaii or at a future conference.
